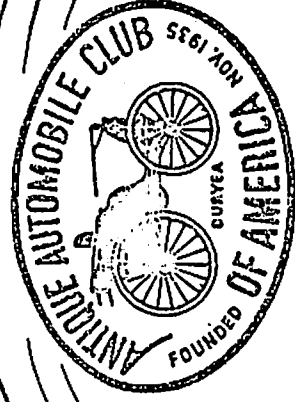

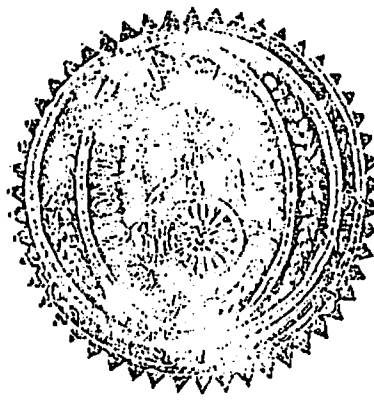


CERTIFICATE OF CHARTER
